The New South Wales South Coast is having an incredible resurgence following the devastating bushfires at the start of 2020, with hotels, resorts, lodges and villas now proving to be some of the most in-demand escapes in Australia.

One of the most exciting products on offer is Bangalay Luxury Villas, located at Shoalhaven Heads, which has a stunning room product as well as a restaurant serving up some of the best meals in New South Wales.

Here you can expect 16 striking villas located adjacent to Shoalhaven Heads Golf Course, the Bangalay Sand Forest and Seven Mile Beach, one of the best stretches of sand anywhere in the state.
